



2013-2014 Profile

Community: The Northmont City School District is 10 miles northwest of Dayton, Ohio in Montgomery County. It includes the cities of Union, Englewood, Clayton, the village of Phillipsburg and small parts of Clay Township, Darke and Miami Counties. The total student population is approximately 6000.

School: Northmont Senior High is a four-year comprehensive, public high school with an enrollment of 1702 students. It has been rated **Excellent** by the Ohio Department of Education twelve consecutive years, four of those years, **Excellent With Distinction**.

Professional Staff: 110 licensed/certificated personnel; average years of experience: 8 years; percent of staff members with advanced degrees: 68%.

National Merit Scholars: For the Class of 2014, one student was recognized as a Semi-Finalist by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation, and one student was recognized by the National Achievement Program.

Curriculum: Over 150 course offerings are available including 4-year sequences in Art, Language Arts, French, German, Spanish and 6 years of mathematics through calculus. Advanced Placement courses are offered in English 11 and 12, Statistics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, American History, Comparative Government, Computer Science, Studio Art, and Music Theory. Other advanced courses offered include Language Arts 9, 11, and 12 Advanced, Language Arts 10 Pre AP, French IV, German IV, Spanish IV, Pre Calculus, Calculus, Anatomy and Physiology, Biology II, and Chemistry II.

Rank in Class: A grade point average (GPA) and a quality point average (QPA) are computed for each student. Both are calculated using final grades in all courses. The GPA is unweighted on a 4.0 scale. The student with the highest GPA in the class is honored as valedictorian and the student with the second highest GPA is honored as salutatorian. The QPA is weighted with quality points earned in AP courses multiplied by a factor of 1.2. The QPA is also weighted with quality points earned in advanced courses multiplied by a factor of 1.1. Class rank is computed using the QPA.
