Implementation Solutions for Limited Lab Time

- ✓ Have students work through smaller assignments. By having them work through less questions at a time, they will have more time to understand each question.
- ✓ Create a class page by using the [Class Manager](#) function. You not only can create assignments there, but you can set the class page as the first thing students see when they login. This will cut down the time it takes for students to get set up and ready to study. By planning assignments ahead of time, all your students will have to do is click on the assignment you have already created.
- ✓ Create assignments that utilize several different standards. You can include up to 10 different topics in your assignment. This will ensure that your students get a well rounded review if you don't have time for them to take each topic separately.
- ✓ Use the [printable worksheet](#) function to create class worksheets. Cut the questions apart for use in stations or class games.
- ✓ Utilize Study Island on your in class computers for the times you are not in the lab by trying the following:
 - Projecting Study Island onto a T.V. or screen so all students can see. By doing this you could use SI questions during instruction and play class games.
 - Have students work through Study Island as a station rotation on your class computers.
 - Have students sign up to use Study Island on your class computers when they have finished work early.
 - Have students login to Study Island when you are tutoring small groups in your classroom.
